

Semiahmoo Fish and Game Club:

Outdoor Archery Range COVID-19 Policies and Procedures

THE CLUB IS OPEN FOR MEMBERS ONLY.
NO GUESTS ALLOWED AT THIS TIME.

All members MUST read and COMPLY TO the following updated RULES while visiting SFGC.
These policies will remain in effect until further notice.

DO NOT enter the property if you are showing **ANY** signs of COVID-19, even if symptoms are “mild”:

- Fever;
- Cough;
- Runny nose;
- Sore throat;
- Shortness of breath;
- If you have traveled outside of Canada in the last 14 days.

Personal Distancing:

- All members are required to comply with physical distancing rules by practicing social distancing and keeping six feet (two meters) away from one another at all times.
- There will be no sharing of any equipment (bows, arrows, tools, etc) between non-household members

Range Capacity & Usage:

- A Maximum Range Capacity of 5 people must be followed AT ALL TIMES.
- The outdoor range will be divided into 5 Shooting Lanes
 - Lane 1: 20y/70m
 - Lane 2: 30y
 - Lane 3: 40y
 - Lane 4: 50y
 - Lane 5: 60y
- Only 1 Participant (or 2 members from the same household) may shoot in the same lane at one time.
- Participants must bring their own targets/target pins.
- To minimize contact, all participants must remove their target after they are done shooting.

Range Schedule:

- Until further notice, the range will be open to participants in the following 2-hour time slots:
 - 7am – 8:30 am. *NOTE: This time slot will be for At-Risk Population only.*
 - 9 am – 10:30 am
 - 11 am – 12:30 pm
 - 1 pm – 2:30 pm
 - 3 pm – 4:30 pm
 - 5 pm – 6:30 pm
 - 7 pm – 8:30 pm
- **THE RANGE IS CLOSED AT 8:30PM**

- Sign-In at the Range is Mandatory:
 - Option 1: Range Sign-In Book (at outdoor range)
 - Option 2: To reduce contact, *Electronic Range Sign-In* is available via the Archery Section of the www.sfgc.ca with Google Forms: [LINK](#).

Arrival/Exit:

- The range will be open for shooting during specific 2-hour time slots (see above).
 - If you arrive at an odd time, do not stay beyond the end of the current time slot.
 - eg If you arrive at 7:45am, you can only stay until 8:30am (when that slot ends)
- Do not enter the range area if there are already 5 members shooting.
- If there are no shooting lanes available when you arrive, you must wait in either the spectator area or your car until the next time slot or a space becomes available.
- Please do not arrive early for a given time slot.
- Do not bring your bow bag into range. Set up your equipment at your car.
- You must be cleaned up and off the range within 15 minutes of the end of each 2-hour time slot.
- Do not gather/loiter in parking lot or any other area of the club. Please pack up and leave immediately to limit the amount of people on the property at one time.
- If you go for a walk on the property after shooting, please move your car away from the range to reduce congestion around the range.

Cleaning Procedures:

- Members are required to sanitize their shooting lane before and after shooting:
 - All touch points: Target Lock, Gate, Gate Hooks, Bow Stand, etc
- It is recommended that all participants bring their own sanitizing equipment such as a diluted bleach solution that meets BC CDC Standards (see document posted at range).
- If a participant does not bring their own sanitizing equipment, there will be diluted bleach solution at the range for cleaning.

Spectators:

- Spectators count towards the 5 Person Range Capacity.
- If there are 5 members shooting, spectators stay outside of the covered range area and **MUST** maintain personal distance from other spectators.
- If you are spectating and another member arrives to shoot, please be respectful and give them the space to shoot.
- Our club rules state that all dogs must be kept on a leash. Please be respectful of other club members and keep your dog on a leash.

Please respect other members.

If we all follow the rules, we will be able to operate safely and enjoy our sport.
